Rules for supporting projects, or how to take advantage of tax reliefs

Suwalska Specjalna Strefa Ekonomiczna S.A. has been successfully supporting and servicing domestic and foreign entrepreneurs investing in northeastern Poland for years.

Within the Polish Investment Zone, the area managed by SSSE S.A. includes all districts of the Podlaskie Voivodeship, 2 districts of the Warmia and Mazury Voivodeship (ełcki and gołdapski) and 4 districts of the Masovian Voivodeship (łosicki, ostrowski, sokołowski and węgrowski).

An entrepreneur investing here may use public aid in the form of exemption from income tax after obtaining the granting decision. The amount of unpaid tax can be as much as **70% of the value** of eligible costs. The condition for benefiting from public assistance is the **implementation of a new project**.

- Creation of a new enterprise
- Increasing production capacity
- Diversification of the company's production by introducing new products
- Changing the production process
- Acquisition of assets belonging to an establishment that has closed or would have closed had the purchase not taken place

WHERE CAN THE PROJECT BE SITED?

The new project can be carried out on public and private land, including land owned by an entrepreneur.

WHAT IS THE VALIDITY PERIOD OF THE DECISION?

In the areas of Podlaskie Voivodeship and in the łosicki, ełcki and gołdapski districts, as well as in the following districts: łosicki, sokołowski and węgrowski – **15 years** In the ostrowski district – **14 years**

HOW TO OBTAIN A DECISION?

The condition for obtaining the decision to support the new project is to meet the quantitative and qualitative criteria of the project:

- Quantitative criteria the minimum costs that the investor is obliged to pay
- Qualitative criteria the minimum number of points qualifying the project in terms of its compliance with the medium-term national development strategy


